Current college students and high school students will compete in separate divisions for scholarships.

- The applicant should have passed all sections of the Ohio Graduation Test (high school applicants only).
- All high school candidates must possess at least a 2.3 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- All college applicants must possess at least a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.

The essay should note how the member plans to contribute or serve people in the communities in which he lives in the future. Or write about: "How a graduating college senior make a smooth transition to Kappa Alumni life?" Include your plan of action if you select the second prompt.

Write a persuasive essay on how you will continually pay your dues as an alumni member of this fraternity given the economic realities of the American society today and the start of your career as you leave college or continue your education in graduate/professional school. Make sure you include practical strategies for achieving these goals.

¹ Freshman forgiveness is a general academic plan to retain capable students who grossly under perform academically during their first year in college. Instead of immediately kicking students out, a college or university may place the student in a program that allows him or her to improve their grades and hence, stay at the college of his/her choice.
